## Responsible Purchasing Policy

Vasava, with the aim of promoting Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) throughout the entire value chain and managing social and environmental risks, has prepared this document to establish a purchasing policy that ensures responsible sourcing and continuous improvement of its impact.

This Policy addresses the ethical, social, labor, and environmental aspects that are most significant and that will later be considered in the process of selecting and evaluating supplier companies.

The value or supply chain is the network between the organization and its suppliers for the production and distribution of a given product or service.

In our case, the value chain represents the stages through which the service passes, from creativity and content production to distribution or consumption.



## *Objectives* of the responsible purchasing policy

## *Prioritization* criteria in the selection of supplier companies

Vasava has set the following objectives:

- To become a benchmark company in CSR within its territory.
- To promote the local economy.
- To respect human rights.
- To advance in responsible environmental management.
- To protect or integrate minority groups, vulnerable groups, or those at risk of social exclusion into the labor market.
- To work toward equal opportunities between men and women.

To achieve the objectives outlined in this policy, Vasava will prioritize contracting companies that meet the following requirements:

- **Local companies** (under equal conditions, preference will be given to those geographically closest). Our objective is to achieve at least 70% local contracting.
- **Companies offering ecological products**, with special emphasis on the following categories:
  - Cleaning
  - Food or catering services
  - Office supplies
  - Paper
  - Electronics (based on energy efficiency criteria)
- **Companies managed according to sustainability criteria**, placing the planet and people at the center. For example, companies that include some of the following aspects in their management:
  - Waste reduction.
  - Energy efficiency and green energy.
  - Promotion of gender equality.
  - Labor inclusion of people with disabilities or at risk of social exclusion.
  - Management based on CSR principles.
  - Priority given to independently owned companies and/or those whose ownership is mostly held by women or individuals from underrepresented groups.
- **Companies with impact-driven business models**, based on solving social or environmental problems.
- **Companies holding environmental, quality, or sustainability certifications** that demonstrate responsible organizational management.

To verify that supplier companies meet these criteria, additional information such as certifications may be required. Supplier companies will also be required to sign a Code of Conduct to guarantee minimum standards of ethical and responsible behavior.
